

# Local Leader Project

As we move through this class, we will discuss many different types of leaders and leadership. This project is designed so that

- 1) you get to learn and teach about a leader that interests you.**
- 2) you get to be the leader of the class for a period.**
- 3) you get to receive meaningful feedback about your presentation and reflect upon the experience.**

You will be doing research on a local leader. This leader can be from Bend, Oregon, or even the Northwest. Once you have your leader selected and researched, you must find a quote on leadership that best fits with his or her “brand” of leadership. When you present, you must begin with the quote and explain in your presentation how this person exemplifies this quote. You must also show evidence of the 5 Practices of Exemplary Leadership for this person.

Your presentation must also include a meaningful activity in which the rest of the class will participate. *Example: a reading of an excerpt written by your leader plus discussion questions; a comparison of the previous presenter’s leader, etc.*

You will sign up for a presentation date next week. Presentations will take place on **Wednesdays**. You are responsible for the entire period *minus time for peer reviews (Approx. 20 min)*.

## Your presentation must include:

- 1. A quote that exemplifies your chosen leader’s brand of leadership**
- 2. Background information about your leader**
- 3. Evidence of the 5 Practices of Exemplary Leadership**
- 4. Pictures and/or a video**
- 5. A meaningful activity for the class to complete**

This project will be worth 100 points. You will be asked to write a reflection after the project and after you receive feedback from your peers about the presentation. This reflection will be a separate grade from the presentation grade.
